<u>Properties</u>— what a material is like and how it behaves (soft, stretchy, waterproof).

<u>Suitability</u> — having the properties that are right for a specific purpose (e.g. glass is suitable for a window because it is transparent/see-through).

Absorbent—a material that soaks up liquid easily.

Opaque—not see through.

Transparent— see through.

Waterproof—does not let water pass through.
