Year 1 Curriculum Overview

English

Spelling – weekly spelling tests focussing on that week's phonics learning, plus common exception words **Grammar and Punctuation** – Pupils will continue to focus on the correct use of capital letters, full stops and spaces between words. They will rehearse sentences orally to ensure they make sense.

Writing - Pupils will learn how to use adjectives to write setting descriptions. They will also learn to write short stories, instructions and short poems. We will continue to use the 'Reading Dogs' to support the pupils' comprehension skills.

Spring Term 2024

Maths

Place Value and Addition and Subtraction

The children will continue to develop number skills, focussing on place value and addition and subtraction. They will learn to partition numbers into tens and ones and write calculations such as 10+8=18, 18-8=10. Children will also learn about measures; length and height, and mass and volume. They will use non-standard units to measure these.

Religious Education

This half term our topic is 'Families and Celebrations'. Pupils will learn about becoming part of God's family and visit St George's church.

Next half term our topic will be 'Following Jesus. Pupils will learn about how Jesus chose the first disciples and what qualities are important in a friend.

The children will also learn about and reflect on the importance of Lent.

Science

This term, the children will be learning about 'Animals including humans'.

They will learn to group and sort animals into the five groups of vertebrate; reptiles, amphibians, mammals, birds and fish. They will also learn the names of animals in these groups and look at what they eat.

Geography

Our topic this half term is "The United Kingdom'. Children will be taught the names of the countries in the UK along with their capital cities and the seas around the UK. They will also learn about physical and human features.

History

In the second half term, our topic will be 'What was life like for our grandparents?' We will look at what household items such as irons and televisions would have looked like and similarities and differences between then and now.

Computing

This term, pupil will learn about coding using Purple Mash. Pupils will learn how to create and run a simple program. They will also learn how to create and debug an algorithm using

Design & Technology

Next half term our DT topic will be 'The Pirate's Lunchbox', They will explore existing products, draw simple designs, make a lunchbox with a handle. The children will then evaluate their product.

Art & Design

This half term the pupils will be learning about printing. They will use their hands to print using paints and explore a range of mediums such as chalks, felt pen and different pencils to create marks
