

Reading Books

Children in KS1 (and those receiving phonics intervention to consolidate knowledge in KS2) will receive **two** reading books from school each week. Children will be reading a variety of good quality fiction, non-fiction and poetry texts:



- 1) Decodable Phonics book - one book will be matched closely to a child's progression through the phonics programme. Your child will have been taught all the graphemes and tricky words in these texts and therefore should be able to decode (sound out) words independently.
- 2) "Read Together" book – this reading book will contain some words or sounds that your child has not yet been taught and therefore may need adult support to read them. *'Read Together' Book Band books will have this sticker on them.*
